NEW FUNDING FOR EAST MIDLANDS HKBNO COMMUNITY PROJECTS

Organisations who help Hong Kongers coming to live and work in the UK have been awarded £2.6 million by the government.

This further year of funding for the Hong Kong British National (Overseas) Welcome Programme for 2023/24 has been allocated to 47 civil society organisations, providing BN(O) visa holders with vital language, employment and mental health support.

The announcement was made at Welcoming Committee for Hongkongers annual conference on Monday, which East Midlands Councils' SMP was pleased to attend.

Since the launch of the Hong Kong BN(O) Welcome Programme in 2021, over 166,000 eligible Hong Kongers and their family members have chosen to make the UK their home by applying for the BN(O) visa.

In the East Midlands, the following organisations have been funded:

- Broxtowe Community Projects (BCP)
- Groundwork Five Counties, which works across the East Midlands
- Reach (EMCF), based across Derbyshire, Nottinghamshire and Leicestershire.

Nationally, Barnardo's and Welcoming Committee for Hong Kongers have received funding to continue their programme of support, and Good Neighbour Church has received funding to provide additional support for HKBNO.
