The Role of the Civic Head, event for Mayors and Deputy Mayors in the East Midlands, 26 May 2021

EMC is hosting a two hour virtual workshop for newly appointed Mayors and deputy Mayors.

The Role of the Civic Head Workshop is part of East Midlands Councils' programme of development offered to Councillors across the region and takes place on 26 May 2021. The programme will include the themes of chairing and effective meetings, scrutiny and communication.

The workshop will explore the role of the Civic Head and the expectations of the role from a range of perspectives, including the expectations of the incoming mayor, and those of the public and the council. It will include short introductory sessions on Chairing Full Council, Public Speaking and Social Media.

Audience - the intended audience for this workshop is newly appointed Mayors and deputy Mayors. Please note that places are limited, we recommend early booking to ensure a place.

Migration, Asylum Support and Refugee Resettlement

National welcome for Hong Kong arrivals - As of 19 March 2021, approximately 27,000 British National (Overseas) (BN (O)) status holders and their family members have applied for a visa since January – this number reflects applications rather than visa holders and is based on internal Home Office management data. More information will be released on how many visas have been granted in the next quarterly migration statistics to be released on 27 May.

Councils in England, who are already playing a key role to ensure BN(O) status holders are warmly welcomed and supported, will benefit from £30.7 million to provide targeted support for new arrivals, covering additional English language training and support with housing costs for those who need it.

There will be 12 welcome hubs delivered through the existing Strategic Migration Partnerships, and in England will work with local authorities, voluntary community and social enterprises. The 12 hubs will work with local authorities and VCSE groups to provide face-to-face support where needed.

A further £5 million will be used to establish 12 virtual welcome hubs across every region in England, and in Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, to co-ordinate support and give practical advice and assistance in applying for school places, registering with GPs and setting up businesses.
