



Greater London Congestion Zone / ULEZ


- 2003 Congestion Zone Central London

- 2023 ULEZ all of Greater London






Automatic Monitoring Station Data NO2





LA Implications England Air Quality Strategy

DEFRA opened a consultation on their Revised Air Quality Strategy, which ran for 10 days from the 11 April 2023 to 11:30pm on 21 April 2023. The short consultation period was attributed to DEFRA being **legally required to publish the revised strategy by 30 April 2023**.

A DEFRA policy paper titled "Air quality strategy: framework for local authority delivery," was published on 28 April 2023. The policy paper identifies actions that local authorities can take to reduce air pollution.

Local Authority Legal Duties

Legal duties placed upon local authorities as stated in the Environment Act 1995 as amended by the Environment Act 2021 states:

- Local authorities (LAs) must assess air quality in their area against air quality objectives.
- LAs **must** submit an Annual Status Report reporting on their air quality actions, including progress implementing Air Quality Action Plans and local Air Quality Strategies.
- DEFRA **must** review their national Air Quality Strategy (NAQS; this is a policy document) every 5 years.




LA Implications England Air Quality Strategy

Key Decision:


- LAs **should** decide whether to revoke/retain/expand smoke control zones
- LAs should decide whether to implement civil penalties within smoke control areas
- LAs **should** take action if air pollution impacts protected sites (biodiversity)
- LAs **should** decide if whether to implement NRMM inside AQMAs
- LAs encourage tenant farmers to reduce ammonia emissions
- LAs should be familiar with best practice on indoor air quality DEFRA will be providing best practice guidance (including mould).
